City Council Meeting
Monday, August 15, 2011

Mayor Nickolay called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Nickolay, Bartusek, Bruzek, Guerrette, Ryan.

Staff Present: Mike Johnson, Ken Ondich, Dennis Seurer, Mark Vosejpkka, Mary Jo Hruby

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Mayor Nickolay acknowledged and congratulated Ron Bruzek on receiving the 2011 Minnesota Class "A" Wastewater Operator of the Year award. Mr. Bruzek has been employed with the City of New Prague since May 1, 1979. He has been the Wastewater Superintendent for the past 22 years.

It was moved by Bartusek and seconded by Bruzek to open the Public Hearing at 7:08 p.m. for the issuance of an On-Sale Liquor License, Off-Sale Liquor License and Dance Permit to Paul Curtis Johnson dba as Pauly's Pub LLC. All voted in favor of the motion. (5-0)

Paul Johnson provided a lease agreement showing "interest" in the premises at 114 West Main Street for which the licenses are to be issued.

The license period is to begin September 1, 2011 and will expire on the last day of March, 2012 in accordance with City requirements.

After questions were answered, it was moved by Guerrette and seconded by Bartusek to close the Public Hearing at 7:17 p.m. All voted in favor of the motion. (5-0)

It was moved by Guerrette and seconded by Bartusek to approve the On-Sale Liquor License, Off-Sale Liquor License and Dance Permit to Paul Curtis Johnson, dba as Pauly's Pub LLC contingent on the applicant showing that they have an "interest" in the premises with a final review by the City Attorney. All voted in favor of the motion. (5-0)

Chris Cavett, SEH presented a report to the Council on the New Prague Business Park - Phase 2.

Police Chief Vosejpkka reviewed with the Council the request from the New Prague Area Education Foundation for Brain Power 5K and 1-mile Fun Run/Walk on September 17, 2011. Both will begin at the New Prague Community Pool parking lot on 3rd Street and they would like permission to use the community pool restroom facilities as well as any electrical outlets if necessary. They agreed to pay the costs incurred for staffing the Pool building, disposable products and extra "No Parking" signs for \$275.00.

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It was moved by Bartusek and second by Ryan to approve the New Prague Area Education Foundation request for Brain Power 5K and 1-mile Fun Run/Walk on September 17, 2011 with the payment of \$275.00 for costs incurred. All voted in favor of the motion. (5-0)

It was moved by Guerrette and seconded by Bruzek to approve the following consent agenda items:
