## FREE Disposal

Free Drop Off For: General refuse, cardboard, scrap metal, vehicle batteries, plastic toys, clean wood (pallets or unpainted 2 x 4s) and co-mingled recycling.

Document Shredding: Veteran Shredding will shred documents for free from 9AM-12PM in the City Hall south parking lot (118 Central Ave N).

Residential Fluorescent Bulbs: All sizes and types of fluorescent bulbs are accepted for free at City Hall all-year round during business hours. Broken bulbs won't be accepted.

## Disposal of Materials at a Fee

Mattress/Box Spring Recycling: From 9AM-12PM at 507/601 12th Street NW (Public Works/Wastewater Treatment Site) Certified Recycling will dispose of only dry mattresses/box springs at a discounted price of \$20 per piece. Payable by cash or check.

Miscellaneous: From 9AM-12PM in the City Hall south parking lot (118 Central Ave N), the following items may be disposed of at a fee (cash or visa): desktop computers (\$25), laptops (\$20), hard drives (\$15), cell phones (\$5). Monitors and TVs not accepted.



## Materials NOT Accepted at Drop Off

- Hazardous waste such as paint, oils, acid thinner, insecticides, and commercial fluorescent light bulbs
- Demolition and/or remodeling materials, including carpet
- Household garbage that's collected via weekly pick-up service



## Additional Information

**Yard Waste:** Tree trimmings and yard waste (branches/leaves) won't be collected at the drop off site, but it can be discarded at the city's yard waste site (1503 Columbus Ave N). The site is available during spring, summer, and fall when the weather is dry. Plastic bags cannot be left behind.

**Miscellaneous Items:** The following items will not be accepted (except certain objects that Veteran Shredding and Certified Recycling will dispose of at an extra fee). However, these items can be disposed of by contacting Laker's New Prague Sanitary directly for pick-up year-round or by dropping off at Scott County Household Hazardous Waste site year-round. A fee will be associated with the disposal of these items.

- For **Appliances, Furniture (couch, chair), Tires, TVs, Brown Goods (CD/DVD, etc), Computer Monitor (any size) & Printer** Disposal Contact Laker's or Scott County HHW for Pricing Information
- For **Used Carpet** Disposal Contact Laker's for Pricing Information
- For **Used Mattress & Box Spring** Disposal go to this Shred Event, or Contact Laker's for Pricing Information
- For **Computer/Laptop** Disposal go to this Shred Event, Contact Laker's or Scott County HHW for Pricing Information
