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This letter is being sent to inform you of construction activity on the above-referenced project.

Holtmeier Construction has completed installation of water main on 3rd Street NE and is currently working on removals of pavement on Sunrise Avenue N ahead of water main, sanitary sewer, and storm sewer construction over the next 2-3 weeks. The contractor has removed only half of the pavement on 3rd Street N to maintain access to driveways. Residents in the project area that do not live on 3rd Street NE are encouraged to find alternate routes to limit the amount of traffic in that area. Street reconstruction crews have not yet been scheduled as gas service and main relocation may still occur.

Residents on Sunrise utility Avenue N should utilize alley access to their homes when possible as reconstruction will make travel difficult to impossible on the street, especially during the workday or when it rains. A second utility crew is expected later next week and work on the project will be more spread out.

As a reminder, please continue to place your garbage and recycling bins at the street as you have previously for collection. If work on the project limits access, the contractor will label and move the bins for collection and bring back to the owner later in the day. To ensure collection occurs, be sure to have bins out the night before or early the morning of collection.

This is also the time to remind everyone that anything within the public right-of-way could be in jeopardy of being damaged and/or removed. This includes landscaping, irrigation or pet containment systems, etc. Locating them and marking them in and near the right-of-way is the property owner's responsibility. It would be helpful for those of you who have irrigation or pet containment systems to contact me so that we are made aware of them. **Any damage to those systems because of failure to locate and mark them will be the property owner's responsibility.**
