This letter is being sent to inform you of construction activity on the above-referenced project.

Holtmeier Construction anticipates completing placement of drain tile, fabric, sand, and gravel today on Sunrise Avenue N and 3rd Street NE. Some work on Saturday morning may occur to finish placement of gravel if weather delays them. This is in preparation for concrete crews to start placement of curb and gutter on Monday on these two streets. It is expected that by the end of the week, some driveways and sidewalk will also be constructed in this part of the project. Following installation, the contractor will spray the fresh concrete with a curing compound giving it a white appearance. Though the concrete may appear dry, it should not be driven on for a minimum of 7 days after placement.

Utility crews will continue work on 1st Street and 2nd Street SE for storm sewer and subcut of the streets. Crews will also begin work on 8th Avenue NW in the City's business park to subcut the street prior to installing sanitary sewer. Sanitary sewer installation will likely start on Thursday or Friday next week. This will require a temporary closure of 6th Street NW for one day to complete the connection at the existing sanitary sewer within the street.

As previously noted, anything within the public right-of-way could be in jeopardy of being damaged and/or removed. Unmarked in-place sprinklers within the right of way have been damaged and will not be repaired by the Contractor. Locating them and marking them in and near the right-of-way is the property owner's responsibility. It would be helpful for those of you who have irrigation or pet containment systems to contact me so that we are made aware of them. **Any damage to those systems because of failure to locate and mark them will be the property owner's responsibility.**
